



### How do I apply for financial aid if I take classes at both institutions?

If you are enrolled in courses at both schools, you should apply for financial aid at Wayne State. You must be a concurrently enrolled WayneDirect student in order to take advantage of financial aid from Wayne State. If you are only enrolled at Macomb, you must apply for financial aid at Macomb. Questions regarding financial aid can be directed to either school: Wayne State (313) 577-3378 or Macomb (586) 445-7228.

### If I participate in WayneDirect, will all of my courses transfer?

Only those courses deemed transferable by Wayne State University will transfer to the university. Visit the transfer equivalency table and transfer plans for Macomb Community College at [transfercredit.wayne.edu](https://transfercredit.wayne.edu) to find out which credits will transfer. Have your current and prior institutions send your transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at Wayne State to receive an official evaluation. Meet with an academic adviser at either school for more information.

## WayneDirect at Macomb

When you're admitted to WayneDirect, you have the upper hand. You'll know your way around campus and who the right people are to talk with about your academic goals — even before you fully enroll in courses at Wayne State. This program is for Macomb Community College students who want to get a head start on earning their bachelor's degree from Wayne State. We even give you the opportunity to concurrently enroll in classes at Wayne State while you continue working toward an associate degree at Macomb. You have the advantage of working with faculty and staff from both institutions to make a smooth transition to Wayne State.

By enrolling in WayneDirect, you have access to Wayne State facilities including the recreation and fitness center, on-campus residence halls (for full-time students) and six libraries. You also get a Wayne State student ID card allowing you to park on campus, check out books and get discounts at local venues. Financial aid is available for students concurrently enrolled at both institutions.

## Be a WayneDirect student

Submit your application today! Macomb WayneDirect applications are available for download online or you can pick one up at the Enrollment Services Offices at Macomb. The WayneDirect application is the only application you need to complete to fully transfer to Wayne State. We do not require an application fee for WayneDirect. To enroll in WayneDirect, you must meet the following criteria:

- Admitted to and currently enrolled at Macomb Community College;
- Comply with Wayne State general admissions requirements; and
- Completed less than 50 credit hours at Macomb.

If you already have 50 credits and/or an associate degree, you should apply directly to Wayne State University as a transfer student. Visit [transfer.wayne.edu](http://transfer.wayne.edu) for more information.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### When can I participate in WayneDirect?

WayneDirect is designed for students just starting their college careers and therefore is only open to those who have earned fewer than 50 total credit hours at any institutions they have attended. Students with more than a total of 50 credits or who have an associate degree can apply as transfer students to Wayne State University by completing the Undergraduate Admissions application.
